


Talk about your favorite part. What makes it your favorite?

Find the word wall words in the book.




## How did you solve tricky words?

Talk about some facts you learned in this book.




Talk about the non-fiction features in this book.







Talk about the main character. How did he/she change from the beginning to the end?




Is this book fiction or nonfiction? How can you tell?
